As you sit down that night to pen a postcard home to your best friend, you have to consider what to write about what you saw.

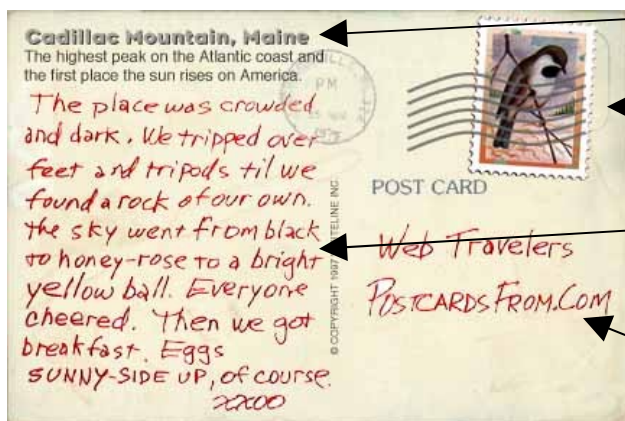
